The Quaker Athletics Booster Club is a group of parent volunteers that work to support the athletes of the Orchard Park School District. We are a community full of talented athletes, fierce competitors and sports enthusiasts incredibly supported by our district. QABC raises money to help provide equipment, training, officials, etc. that is not covered in the athletic budget. Money is raised primarily at our concession stands and our annual golf tournament.

We have seen a significant decline in volunteers in the last few years, likely due to the pandemic, and we are looking to revitalize the group. We know there are parents, coaches and community members who are willing to be a part of QABC.

Beginning in fall 2022, we would like a parent representative from every OP sport, every level, to attend three QABC meetings a year. That parent will represent his/her child's team and relay information back regarding QABC events and initiatives. Every team that has a parent representative will receive \$200.00 to use however the team would like (shirts, end of the year celebration, etc.).

If your team has a representative who attends the meetings, coaches are welcome to make requests to the QABC. Teams without representation will not be eligible for QABC funding.

QABC meets monthly and would love attendance at all meetings. The three mandatory meeting dates for parent representatives in the 2022-2023 school year are as follows: **September 14th, December 14th, and April 12th at 6:00pm**. Meeting location to be determined.
