## Supply List for all grades 2020-2021

### Kindergarten

- (1) primary ruled composition notebook (lines on bottom half only, top portion solid white)
  - (1) composition notebook (wide ruled)
  - (1) art smock or t-shirt for art
  - (1) towel – for rest time (no pillows please) (must be able to fit in cubby)
  - backpack – large enough to fit a folder, sneakers, and lunch box. (please – no book bags with wheels)
  - (1) vinyl pocket folder – (take home folder) color/pattern of your choice
  - (1) red vinyl pocket folder with prongs
  - (1) green vinyl pocket folder with prongs
  - (1) Pack of POST IT Sticky Notes (3" x 3" size)
  - (1) Pack of POST IT Sticky Notes (2" x 1-1/2" size)
  - Fiskars blunt tipped children's scissors
  - (6) packs of Crayola crayons (24 count) Please no scented, twistable or sparkle crayons.
  - (3) boxes of SKINNY Crayola markers, fine point
  - (1) pack of black Papermate Flare Pens
  - (1) pack of #2 pencils (please no mechanical) - pre-sharpened
  - supply box- 1 large sturdy zipper cloth pencil case (no plastic)
  - (4) large ELMER'S gluesticks
  - (1) bottle of ELMER'S liquid glue
  - dry erase markers (4 black low odor)
  - 1 large old sweatshirt, labeled with name (for emergency use)
  - full change of clothes (each piece labeled with name) in a zipped baggie

- \*\* Please label all towels, t-shirts, boots, jackets, snow pants and all outerwear with your child's name.

### Grade 2

- (1) supply box, to keep all supplies in
- (1) package of 12 colored pencils (sharpened)
- (1) thin highlighter – fine tip
- (3) low odor fine tip dry erase markers – black only
- pack of 12 #2 pencils (sharpened), labeled with name
- (2) pink erasers
- (5) large glue sticks, to be replaced throughout the year
- very large sweatshirt or sweater for emergency use
- art smock (old shirt, labeled)

### Grade 1
