



New Parent Volunteer Orientation

Dear Parents,

The Parent Volunteer Program provides parents, guardians, and other interested adult family members the opportunity to get involved at South Davis by assisting students and teachers with school projects and activities. Parent volunteers engage in assignments that range from helping out in the classroom to assisting in the cafeteria, library or computer room. Most requests for volunteers come from our teachers. The amount of time you are willing to commit to volunteering is entirely up to you! You can volunteer to work with all grade levels or specify that you prefer to work only with your own child's grade or classroom.

For those parents, guardians, and adult family members, who have NEVER attended an orientation at South Davis and wish to volunteer, the Orchard Park Central School District requires that all volunteers attend a volunteer orientation only ONCE in an elementary building.

Volunteers are required to complete the volunteer application and include your Driver's License number and 2 personal references. Submitting an application is not a commitment in itself, it merely indicates your interest in the program. The acceptance of any assignment is at your discretion.

The New Parent Volunteer Orientations will cover all programs and guideline to follows.
