

Born Political Identity

An Exercise in Intergenerational Social Studies

Directions: Talk to an adult family member and type a 1 page analysis of their *political ideology, party affiliation and political efficacy.*

Your analysis should include the following:

- A description of this person's political ideology and *three* factors that influenced the development of this person's political ideology. (Ideology is the person's beliefs about what government should do...i.e. liberal/conservative.)
- A description of this person's association (or non-association) with a political party and a description of the factors that influenced this association.
- A description of this person's political efficacy and the factors that influenced this person's political efficacy (Efficacy is the person's belief that voting and other involvement matters).

--Focus on HOW the person interviewed developed their beliefs.
