

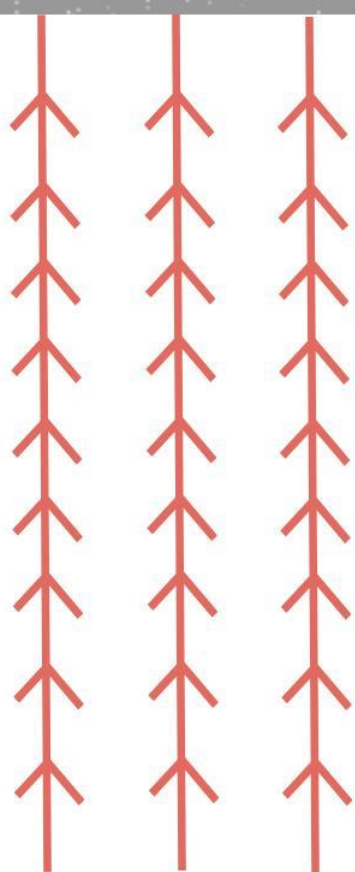

All about ISFPs

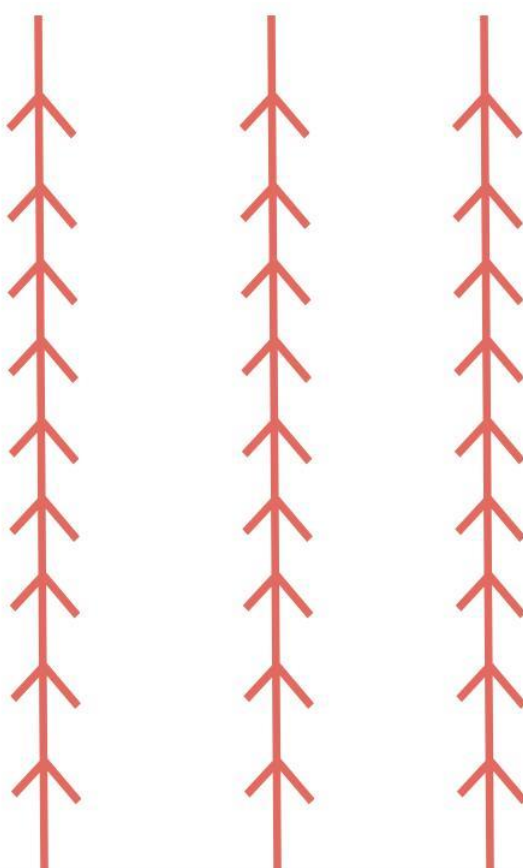
