2019-2020 **Grade 8** Supply List

This is a list of supplies used by all the 8th grade bases. It may be necessary to purchase some additional supplies when school begins, to meet individual base teacher preferences, but we have tried to keep additional purchases to a minimum.

General Supplies:

- Zippered pencil case (NO PLASTIC BOXES, please)
- **Blue** or **black** pens
- Box of pencils
- Box of colored pencils
- A fine tip marker
- Highlighters (3 different colored highlighters)
- Ruler with metric and standard measure
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Headphones (earbuds) standard size 3.5mm or USB for use with Chromebook
- 2-3 packages of loose-leaf paper
- 2 locks (1 for on-base locker and 1 for gym locker) - It is strongly recommended that the locks be purchased from the Middle School. They will have the same combination and if there is a problem, there is a master key available to open them.

Students taking Algebra I: please **do not** purchase a graphing calculator; one will be provided by the school district.

Social Studies (items are to be red) (or white Binder with clear pocket insert for colored paper)

1"3-ring binder

1 large spiral notebook, single subject

Red folder with clasps and pockets

1:12:1 and 1:15 Social Studies – 1 **red** 2" 3-ring binder, 3 **red** folders with pockets, highlighter, **red** spiral notebook

World Languages (items are to be purple)
